- working definition of Internet governance: "Internet governance is the development and application of shared principles, norms, rules, decision-making procedures, and programs that shape the evolution and use of the Internet by governments, the private sector, and civil society in their respective roles."
- established the Internet Governance Forum
- 2015 WSIS+10 Outcome Document
